Interdepartmental by nature, research is pursued in either Cambridge (in the Departments of Molecular and Cellular Biology; Chemistry; Physics; SEAS; etc.) or Boston (including Harvard Medical School, Division of Medical Sciences, and 11 Harvard-affiliated hospitals).

- Interactive program activities throughout the year


#### GUARANTEED FUNDING


For the duration of the PhD for students in good standing
